SETTING UP OS X DIALER

1) Click on the **Apple Icon** in the top left-hand side of your screen and select **System Preferences**, then click on the **Network** icon.

2) TCP/IP tab
 Location: select New Location, name it Highway Internet then click OK.
 Show: Internal Modem
 Domain Name Servers (optional) : leave blank
 Search Domains (optional) : leave blank

3) PPP tab
Service Provider: hwy.com.au
Telephone Number:
Mudgee- 63725000 (if you're a local call to Mudgee)
Dubbo and all other areas nationally: 0198333530
NB: It is the customer's reponsibility to check that this is definitely a local call for you. Please contact your phone provider or call Telstra on 1800 113 011.

Password: (your password) Tick "Save Password"

4) Click on **PPP Options** then tick the option to "Connect automatically ..." then click Save.

5) Your dial-up connection has now been configured for your Highway account. Your OS X will dial up and connect you automatically, however, should you wish to connect manually, click on the **Finder** icon in the dock, then click on the **Applications** icon and click on the **Internet Connect** icon to get online. Optionally, you can click and drag this icon down to your dock as a shortcut to connect up.

SETTING UP OS X EMAIL

1) On the bottom left cornet of the screen, click on the postage stamp to open the mail program.

2) Click on Mail then Preferences and then on the Accounts icon. Click on Create Account.

- ii) Download messages from this account into folder: INBOX
- 5) Click OK to save.
